What are they? **The Old Testament & New Testament**

At the start of the Old Testament, what did God create? **The whole world!**

In how many days? **6**

At the start of the New Testament, what special baby was born? **Jesus**

The first 4 books of the New Testament are called the gospels. Name them.

Matthew, Mark, Luke and John

What does "gospels" mean? **The good news about Jesus!**

FOR KIDS ENTERING 1ST - 3RD GRADES-

Know the questions above as well as the New Testament Books.

FOR KIDS ENTERING 4TH - 6TH GRADES-


Know the New Testament Books as well as the "Story of the Bible" rhyme.

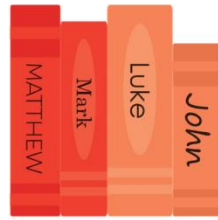

HISTORY



Acts explains how the church began and grew after Christ's death and resurrection, and how Christ's message was spread across the world.

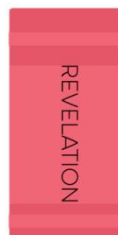
LETTERS



Paul's letters to churches and to people.

There are 8 other New Testament letters. The letters were written to encourage, inform, and correct.

PROPHECY



The final book of the Bible is a book of prophecy by John.
