Many have asked when we will be able to meet for worship at the building again. That time is coming very soon! Our Elders met Tuesday night and confirmed our June 7 date.

We will have two separate worship times offered on Sunday mornings:

- **8:30 AM Worship** – This worship time is intended for those 65 and older. We ask that no children be present at this service time. Our goal is to provide a safe environment for those that are higher risk.
- **10:00 AM Worship** – This worship time will be for all others. We will also be continuing to livestream this service time for those who do not feel comfortable attending at this point.

Please bear in mind that we will continue to offer Sunday evening and Wednesday evening devotionals and Bible studies as we have over the past several weeks. We want to encourage everyone to continue making these a priority. As followers of Christ, we know our mission is sharing the Gospel. One way that you can spread the Word of God during this time is to “share” our devotional and Bible study videos with your friends, either on social media or through email. We have found that many who are not connected to the Church are tuning-in to our online services. So, even though these times have been strange, we know that God can and will bring good out of this. Help us continue to spread the message of Christ to our community and world!

We are continuing to monitor the situation and will be making any schedule adjustments necessary to ensure the safety and well-being of each member and guest. Information has been gathered from various sources and the following determinations have been made concerning our services at WindSong as the COVID-19 pandemic continues. The following page outlines specific guidelines to be observed as we come together again. Please read them carefully and follow them to the best of your ability. Our goal is to offer the safest environment possible for all our members and guests.

COVID-19 Worship Guidelines

- If you do not feel comfortable attending services at this point, we encourage you to stay home and worship with us online.
- Services at the building will be in the Fellowship Center on Sunday mornings until further notice.
- We are taking the following precautions as we meet together again:
 - o Doors will be propped open for contactless entrance and exit.
 - o Hand sanitizer will be provided at each entrance.
 - o Communion will be distributed as you enter the assembly. Contribution boxes will be available as you exit following worship.
 - o Rows will be spaced 6 feet apart and safe social distance will be maintained between family groups.
 - o Chairs will be sanitized following each assembly.
 - o We will dismiss our assembly by rows, and you are asked to visit in the parking lot.
- If you have underlying health conditions or are immunocompromised, we encourage you to stay home and worship with us online during our 10:00 AM service.
- Individuals are asked to not enter the building if:
 - o They have had a fever of 100 degrees or higher in the past 2 days.
 - o They have a persistent cough, shortness of breath, or other symptoms typical of COVID-19.
 - o They have had known exposure to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- Family groups are asked to enter the building as a group.
 - o Families will be able to enter through either the Fellowship Center entrance or the main entrance.
 - o Family groups will be seated together.
 - o We ask that all family groups stay together.
 - o We will not have an attended nursery or Bible Hour. Changing tables are available in restrooms if needed.
 - o All areas of the building will be closed off with the exception of the Fellowship Center, foyer, and restrooms.
- Masks are encouraged to be worn.
- We ask that you refrain from shaking hands or hugging. We understand that this may be difficult for those who are accustomed to greeting one another in this manner, but we ask that you make this adjustment for the safety of all members and guests.
- Please use proper coughing and sneezing etiquette. Please cough or sneeze into a tissue or your elbow.
- These guidelines are not intended to be restrictive but are intended for the safety and well-being of each member and guest. Please continue to pray for our Elders as they continue to lead through these challenging times.
